

OUTDOOR BLINDS MEASURING SHEET

While you are measuring your space please keep in mind any extras you might need like hoodboxes, back angles, posts and spacers and also think about what fabrics or colours might suit your space. You will also need to decide what type of operation you want for each of your blind (manual or motorised) and on which side of each blind you want the operation mechanism to sit (left or right). If you are unsure of any of these things please refer to the website.
